Before you embark on what will no doubt be one of the most transformative experiences of your life, please review and acknowledge your willingness to abide by the behavioral expectations set forth below. Please initial each paragraph after reading and sign at the bottom.

1. Except for excused absences, I will attend all classes and program activities as detailed in program syllabus. I understand that failure to comply may affect my final grade.

2. I understand that the UA Student Code of Conduct (Code) applies to my participation in a SASE study abroad program (Program). I agree to review the Code:

Disciplinary response to violations of the Code is at the discretion of the Program Lead (Lead) in consultation with SASE and the UA Dean of Students. Violations of the Code, especially as it refers to student housing, may be a cause for immediate expulsion from the Program, necessitating my return to the U.S. at my own expense.

3. I understand that I am required to complete and turn in an Emergency Contact and Independent Travel form prior to any non-Program-related overnight travel.

4. I will not engage in any conduct that is illegal in my Program host country or offensive to its culture. I also will not engage in any behavior that is disruptive to the Program.

5. I understand that use of illegal drugs or misuse of *prescription drugs and/or alcohol is a serious problem that can not only affect my own health and welfare, and the welfare of my co-students, but also adversely affect the reputation of the Program. I will familiarize myself with applicable laws and cultural sensitivities of my Program host country and will honor all such laws and sensitivities. I understand that failure to do so may result in me being charged under the Code and may also result in expulsion from the Program and return to the United States at my own expense.

6. I understand that if I am incarcerated during the dates of the Program I may be expelled from the Program I also understand that the University will be under no obligation to provide legal assistance to me should I be arrested or incarcerated.

7. I realize that I am a representative of the University of Arizona. As such a representative, I understand that any actions I take abroad may affect opinions about the University and may adversely affect future study abroad opportunities for myself and for others.
