Portfolio (100 points)

A) Relevant image/painting (15 points)

- Resolution and quality of the image (3 points)
- Appropriate to the specific time period of the chosen text (3 points)
- Appropriate to the specific language and culture of the chosen text (3 points)
- Information on the artist, title and date are provided (3 points)
- Source of the image is provided (3 points)

B) Relevant image/building (15 points)

- Resolution and quality of the image (3 points)
- Appropriate to the specific time period of the chosen text (3 points)
- Appropriate to the language and culture of the chosen text (3 points)
- Information on the architect, title and date are provided (3 points)
- Source of the image is provided (3 points)

C) Manuscript (10 points)

- Identify where the manuscript/text is currently housed (5 points)
- Identify the call number of the manuscript/text (5 points)
- (at times there are, of course, many manuscripts, so pick at least a major one, upon which your text was edited)

D) Create a bibliography using a monograph as a starting point (10 points)

- Bibliographic information is on top of the page (5 points)
- Identify 5 major studies to which the author has referred (5 points)

E) Create a bibliography using an online database (10 points)

- Bibliography is relevant to the text (5 points)
- Bibliography consists of at least 5 studies (5 points)

F) Modern Study on the text chosen (30 points)

- The study is modern and not older than 1960 (5 points)
- Bibliographical information is provided (3 points)
- A copy of the article is provided (2 points)
- Critical summary:

- length around 500 words (5 points)
- Structure and coherence (5 points)
- The student conveys what the author says and argues (10 points)

G) The Portfolio is presented in a neat and professional manner (10 points)
